**APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA**

Councilmember Steve Ward moved, seconded by Councilmember Carolyn Karns and carried 5-0, to approve the consent agenda, to include adoption of the agenda, approval of the minutes of the December 21, 2009 Council meeting, and approval of the amended bills.

**CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT**

**COUNCIL/COMMISSION REPORTS**

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

Mayor Curt Shreckengaust presented an Ordinance for new construction projects on properties located within 100 feet of the centerline of K-68 (Amity). No building permit shall be issued in the Temporary Moratorium Area until 6 months from the effective date of this ordinance, or

the repeal, or amendment of this ordinance. Councilmember Glenna Windisch moved, seconded by Sid Mitchell and carried 5-0, to adopt Ordinance 970 Establishing a Temporary Building Permit Moratorium.

**ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT**

City Administrator Jeff Cantrell presented the Safe Routes to School Construction Contract. One bid from Amino Brothers was submitted in the amount of \$168,995.58. This bid was under the engineer’s estimate. KDOT stated it was rare, but acceptable to award a project if there is only one bid. The construction cost will be reimbursed as part of the \$250,000 grant for the project. Councilmember Steve Ward moved, seconded by Councilmember David Cannon and carried 5-0, to accept the bid from Amino Brothers, conditioned on approval from KDOT.
